### HOA

#### What does the HOA do?

- Provides community services as approved by the Board of Directors
- Processes design review modification requests
- Enforces community standards, guidelines and policies
- Hires and trains all Association staff members
- Bills and receives all member assessments
- Maintains the financial records of the Association
- Assists the Board in preparing the budget
- Staffs, operates, and maintains the Association amenities and common areas
- Resident-only lifestyle programming and events

### How much are the HOA assessments?

The total due is **\$93.78 per month**<sup>\*</sup>, billed directly to homeowners on a quarterly basis. The quarterly amount covers the \$80/month HOA assessment and includes an additional \$13.78/month fee for trash and recycling collection.

### When are assessments due?

Billed quarterly, assessments are due on the first day of January, April, July, and October.

### THE METRO DISTRICT

Harmony is located within the Powhaton Community Authority and Powhaton Road Metropolitan District Nos. 2 and 3—collectively, the "District." The District was formed to support the development and maintenance of vital infrastructure and amenities for the Harmony community, including the community parks, basketball/volleyball courts, open space trails, certain common areas, detention ponds, fencing adjacent to common areas, and certain portions of the underdrain system. The District is also responsible for snow removal along certain common area sidewalks and the Ellsworth Avenue drive lanes.

Costs associated with the administration, operations, and maintenance of the public improvements owned and operated by the District are paid for by tax revenues collected through mill levies imposed by the District and through an operations fee, currently set at **\$25 per quarter**. A \$100 transfer fee is due upon any transfer/sale of property.
